Frequently asked questions

1. When does the virtual reskilling sales program course at the University of St. Gallen begin and end?

The two-week virtual course starts on 07 June 2021 and ends on the evening of June 18th.

2. What is the next step for me after completing the course?

At the end of the two-week course you will receive an official diploma from the University of St. Gallen. You will also receive a written analysis of your strengths and areas of development.

In the next step, you will be matched with Lionstep's partner companies and accompanied by our specialists throughout the entire recruitment process.

3. What is the probability that I will find a job?

The goal is to place at least 50% of the participants in new jobs. The probability therefore also depends on your own expectations and skill set to be happy in the new position in the long run.

4. What are the requirements to participate in the course?

- You are at least 18 years old
- You are allowed to work in Switzerland
- You understand English course content

5. What material do I need to participate in the course?

To participate in the virtual course, it is important that you have a tablet, laptop or PC with which you can participate in the workshops and lessons.

6. How much does the course cost?

The collaboration with our partners makes it possible for us to offer the entire program, including a diploma from the University of St. Gallen, at an extremely affordable price of only CHF 400.00 (normal price CHF 3,000.-).
